

2016 Amundsen Expedition - Overview

Overview

This expedition plan is based on discussions held at the 2016 *Amundsen* Expedition Planning Workshop in Montreal and minor adjustments received since then.


On 03 June the CCGS Amundsen is scheduled to leave its homeport of Quebec City for a 125-day expedition to the Canadian Arctic in support of several research programs. Based on the science objectives, the expedition has been divided into 6 separate segments (3 legs):

- Leg 1a: Quebec to Qikiqtarjuaq (03 to 23 June)
- Leg 1b: Qikiqtarjuaq to Iqaluit (23 June to 14 July)
- Leg 2a: Iqaluit to Qikiqtarjuaq (14 to 27 July)
- Leg 2b: Qikiqtarjuaq to Kugluktuk (27 July to 25 August)
- Leg 3a: Kugluktuk to Kugluktuk (25 August to 17 September)
- Leg 3b: Kugluktuk to Quebec City (17 September to 06 October)


