



SCRIPPS GRADUATE APPLICATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

As a leader at UC San Diego and in the field of geosciences, Scripps Institution of Oceanography is taking proactive steps to support the Chancellor's call to create a more diverse campus by offering a program that seeks to demystify the graduate application process and support students who have been systematically marginalized and/or historically excluded from academia.

GAAP offers 3 unique program components.

1. Informational Workshops about Applying to Graduate School (Open to All)

August 25, 2022 - Research at Scripps

Learn about the variety of research being done at Scripps and how to identify potential research projects

September 1, 2022 - Life at Scripps

Hear what it is like to live in San Diego, and a day in the life of a graduate student, particularly from the perspective of underrepresented students

September 8, 2022 - Applying to Scripps

Learn tips and tricks to creating a strong application

September 15, 2022 - Writing Workshop

Learn how to craft a compelling Personal Statement and CV

All workshops are 12:30 - 1:30 PST // Participants who attend all 4 workshops may be eligible to receive an application fee waiver.

2. 1:1 Introductory Meetings with Scripps Scholars (Limited Spaces Available)

3. SIO-ASK // Personalized Application Mentorship and Assistance (Open to students who will submit an application to Scripps for this year's application cycle)

Scripps Graduate Application opens September 7, 2022 and closes December 7, 2022.

GRE will not be required for Fall 2023 admission. If you have already taken the test, you can include your scores on your application.

These programs are brought to you as a collaboration between Scripps Office of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, and SIO-ASK (SIO Application Skills & Knowledge, a personalized mentorship effort led by current Scripps graduate students).

Students of all backgrounds and/or demographics are welcome to apply. Students who have been historically or are currently underrepresented or underserved in marine and geosciences who attend minority-serving institutions (HBCUs, TCUs, and/or HSIs) are **strongly encouraged** to apply.
