We seek outstanding candidates for a faculty position at Scripps Institution of Oceanography. Candidates should have a history of innovative research activities at the intersection of marine natural products and human health. We will consider applicants with a marine focus from a broad range of fields including, but not limited to: natural products chemistry, biocatalysis, synthetic biology, pharmacology, and chemical ecology. The successful candidate will be expected to develop a strong extramurally supported research program that integrates with and aids the growth of existing marine natural products research at SIO and UC San Diego, and, in particular, at the Center for Marine Biotechnology and Biomedicine (CMBB, <https://scripps.ucsd.edu/cmbb>).

We intend to fill one position, at either the Assistant (tenure track) or Associate/Full (tenured) level, although there is a preference for those at early career stages. Institutional procedures require separate applications for untenured and tenured levels. Candidates who are unsure of their appropriate level are encouraged to apply at both levels. Rank and salary will be determined by qualifications and based on University of California pay scales.

For applicants to the Assistant Professor position, applications will be evaluated for research productivity, plans for the future, alignment with priorities, vision for teaching, mentoring, and service, and promotion of equity, diversity and inclusiveness. For applications to the Associate/Full Professor position, applications will be evaluated for research productivity, past and future funding, alignment with priorities, experience and plans for teaching and mentoring, leadership and scientific vision, service, and promotion of equity, diversity and inclusiveness.
